The patient usually had active bleeding but the stool occult blood screening test never showed positive result. This case was investigated. The quality control

of the stool occult blood test is rechecked. The final problem is identified and due to prozone effect.

## **DISCUSSION**

Prozone effect is an important phenomenon seen in immunodiagnosis [2]. The disturbance of diagnosis by immunological technique is possible if there is an excessive antigen. The problem is common in seroimmunodiagnosis. For the stool occult blood test, some test kits are based on immunological principle. It is no doubt that the prozone effect can occur and lead to false negative result.

In the present case, it is overt that the patient has gastrointestinal bleeding due to hemorrhoids. A big amount of blood can be expected. This might mean that there are many antigens in stool occult blood test, hence, the false negative result can be expected.
