CASE STUDY

The case is a 23 years old female who has short eyesight and wear spectacle. The patient accidentally fall and get the eye injury by the broken spectacle. The eye injury is managed by ophthalmologist. Luckily, there is only a minor corneal abrasion and external skin laceration below the lower eyelid that requires 5 stiches suture. The complete recovery can be derived within 1 week.

DISCUSSION

Spectacle related injury is an important problem in the present day. Due to the widely use of spectacle, good design of the eyeglasses

is needed. Hoskinet al. noted that "With increased understanding of specific risk factors, performance guidelines can be developed for prescription spectacle eye-protection requirements [1]." In the present case, the problem is minor, however, a more serious case can also be seen. More serious cases usually related to traffic accident. For example, the air bag popping up after car crash might be the cause of eyeglasses related eye injury [2 - 3].
